	Microsoft Teams Online Interview	Face-to-Face Interview
Preparation	Visit our website and get a good understanding of what we do. Have a read through the Job Description and our Values and Behaviours Framework to see what we believe is important. Think about how our values align with yours and bring examples to the interview. Whether you have worked in social care before or not, we will be looking for you to give some examples from your life that show how you display our values and work well with people. It also helps us to get to know you! It's not just about skills; we believe that people get great support when the teams that support them have the right mix of values, personality, skills, and interests. Our interviews are designed to help you demonstrate what you are good at and to show us what kind of person you are.	
	Ensure that you have accepted the calendar invite for the scheduled interview.	Ensure you have the details of where the interview will be taking place. It may help you to plan your route to us in advance.
	Prepare your surroundings – make sure you are in a place where you can minimise distractions and interruptions.	Some of our roles require a presentation. If this is part of your interview, ensure this is completed prior to the interview and sent over to the recruitment team or panel.
	Ensure you have access to either a laptop, tablet, or phone to do your interview. Test your equipment to ensure the camera and microphone are working.	When you arrive at the interview, let the receptionist know that you have arrived. They will ask you to sign in and show you where to wait.
Pre-Interview	We don't work in suits, so smart/casual clothing is fine.	
	Have a glass of water nearby.	Bring water with you or ask for some at the start of the interview.
	Join the interview five minutes before the official start time. This will give you time to adjust the lighting for the camera and ensure your microphone and sound is working.	Arrive at the venue ten minutes prior to the interview to give yourself time to prepare.

	Microsoft Team Online Interview	Face to Face Interview
During the interview	<p>We want to know why you want to work with us – bring your passion and enthusiasm for the role with you!</p> <p>Try and answer questions concisely. It may help to make bullet points of what you want to say to help keep you on track.</p> <p>If you need a question to be repeated, ask.</p> <p>We want you to be able to show us who you really are.</p> <p>The panel will be taking notes, which helps them to remember what has been said. They are listening to you!</p> <p>This is your chance to find out more about us and what it will be like working with us. You'll have the opportunity to ask questions, so think about what you'd like to know in advance and make the most of this opportunity!</p>	
	<p>If for any reason the connection disconnects, try not to worry, just re-join as soon as you can.</p>	
Close of Interview	<p>After the interview, the panel should tell you about next steps. This could be about any further interview stages, or the timescale for letting you know the outcome.</p>	
	<p>Wait until the panel ends the call.</p>	<p>Sign out at reception.</p>
